Due to the pandemic NADA currently does not allow guests inside the store, but you can place order in advance and pick it up on the curbside.

- **The Soap Dispensary**

Vancouver's first dedicated refill store established in 2011. The Soap Dispensary, much like NADA sells both food and household staples (or kitchen staples, as they call it themselves). Although their website is currently being updated, you can visit them in their store on Main street.



- **Livlite**
