The course covers the history of South Asia from the rise of the British East India Company in the 1600s through the emergence of anti-colonial rebellion and the beginnings of nationalist politics in the late 1800s. Throughout we will place developments in South Asia in the context of developments in economic, intellectual, and political life that marked the world at large in a global age of empire and revolution.
