JAPN_V 361 Intensive Intermediate Japanese I

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An integrated course covering topics on various aspects of Japanese language, culture, customs, and cross-cultural communication designed for students who wish to develop linguistic, socio-linguistic, and strategic competencies in speaking, listening, reading and writing modern Japanese at an intermediate level. Class consists of a combination of lectures, pair works, group activities and discussions.

It is strongly recommended that students plan to complete both JAPN 360 and JAPN 361 within one year. Credit will be granted for only one of JAPN 361 or JAPN 251 or both JAPN 212, JAPN 213 or both JAPN 322, JAPN 323. Recommended pre-requisites: one of JAPN 211, JAPN 250, JAPN 321, JAPN 360. This course is not eligible for Credit/D/Fail grading.

Mode of Delivery: 100% in-person class. In general, the class meetings will focus on interacting with your instructor and peers and practicing course content. You are required to preview materials for kanji, vocabulary, grammar, reading and other materials as decided by the instructor in order to get the most out of the class.
