KORN_V 200 - Intermediate Korean

This 6-credit course aims to consolidate students' knowledge of the fundamental grammatical structures of Korean and to increase their ability to communicate on a wide range of daily life situations and to discuss basic information about current socio-cultural topics in Korean. Thus, upon successful completion of this course, students will reach an Intermediate high level, which allows students to be able to handle "uncomplicated tasks and social situations requiring an exchange of basic information related to their work, school, recreation, particular interests, and areas of competence" (ACTFL Proficiency Guidelines, 2012).

Mode of Delivery: Hybrid, Mixed. The class meets in person on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays. Students study the provided materials asynchronously and meet online on Thursdays from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM.
