## JAPN\_V 402 - Advanced Modern Japanese: Conversation and Composition I

This course is designed for students who wish to improve their communicative proficiency in speaking and writing at an advanced level. It offers an in-depth exploration of various linguistic and cultural aspects of the Japanese language. Students learn about different aspects of Japanese culture, language, and society through readings, discussions, and research on a variety of social issues.

This course will help students develop further fluency, grammatical accuracy, proper pronunciation and intonation, appropriate social register, and intercultural communication skills, while gaining a deeper understanding of the rich cultural tapestry of Japan. Each year, the instructor may incorporate a specific theme related to Japanese society and culture. Previous themes have included topics related to Cultural Norms, Communication, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI).
