CNTO 403 Intermediate Cantonese II is designed for learners of Cantonese who have completed CNTO 401 Intermediate Cantonese I or its equivalent. This course will focus on both intermediate conversational and presentational skills in Cantonese. Current colloquial and professional speech is the main focus. Students will also learn about Cantonese culture through specialized social topic driven language lessons and presentations. The course adopts a communicative language teaching approach which emphasizes the exclusive use of target language in performing various language tasks in the classroom and on various authentic media platforms. Students will receive instructions with material support from a grammar textbook and authentic materials while providing their own professional contexts.
