JAPN_V 320 - Intermediate Japanese I A

An integrated course covering topics on various aspects of Japanese language, culture, customs, and cross-cultural communication designed for students who wish to develop linguistic, sociolinguistic, and strategic competencies in speaking, listening, reading and writing modern Japanese at an intermediate level. Class consists of a combination of lectures, pair works, group activities and discussions. It is strongly recommended that students plan to complete both JAPN 320 and JAPN 321 within one year. Credit will be granted for only one of JAPN 320 or JAPN 210 or JAPN 360. Recommended pre-requisites: one of JAPN 103, JAPN 151, JAPN 201, JAPN 260. This course is not eligible for Credit/D/Fail grading.
