Students will read texts on Korean current issues, culture, customs and contemporary life, and write on a variety of topics in different styles. Students will gain practice in reading, speaking, listening and writing for different purposes using complex vocabulary and grammar. Students will also improve their listening and speaking skills through in-class activities, assignments and presentation.
