This course is a continuation of PERS 100 and focuses on further developing students' Interpersonal, Interpretive, and Presentational skills to the Novice High/Intermediate Low proficiency level. Key topics include describing appearance and personality, describing and narrating the process of a trip to Iran, and describing and narrating about a city (Isfahan and Shiraz) in Iran.
