## **PUNJ\_V 102 - Introductory Punjabi**

This online course is designed as an introduction to Punjabi (Gurmukhi) script and modern Punjabi language. At the end of the course, students are expected to have mastered basic vocabulary and grammar and will be able to read, write and converse at the introductory level.

Topics Covered: Punjabi Alphabet and Vowel Markers; Numbers (1-100); Demonstrative Pronouns, Interrogative Particle and Auxiliary Verb “To Be”; Gender; Singular and Plural; Adjectives; Personal Pronouns and different forms of the auxiliary verb “to be” in the present tense; Verbs; Post Positions; Possessive Pronouns; Interrogative Adverbs and Adverbs of Place; Auxiliary verb “to be” in the past tense; Direct and Oblique cases; Dative Case Forms of Pronouns; Ordinal Numbers; Superlatives; Verb Roots and Imperatives - informal, formal and polite; Present Indefinite Tense; Present Continuous and Past Continuous Tense; The Future Tense; Past Habitual Tense; The Perfective form of the Verb; Expression of Times; Word Order.
